**Course includes:** One day of instruction, class handouts and the use of simulation and test equipment.

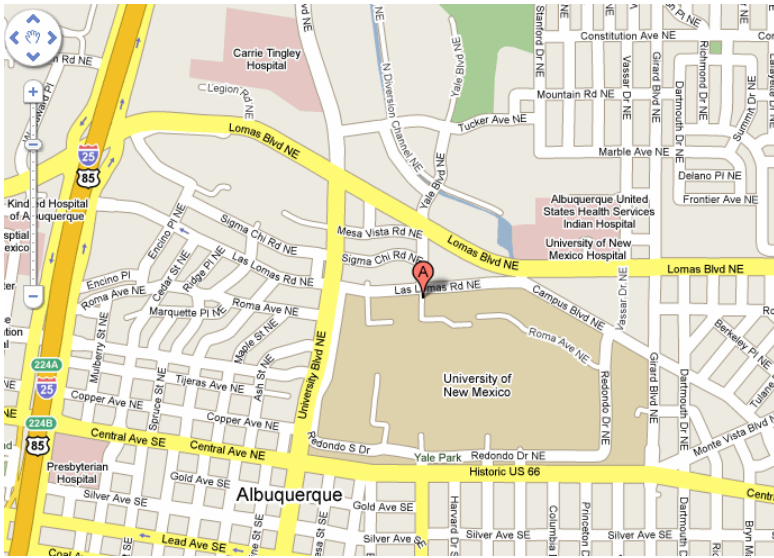
