Course includes: Course includes a half day of instruction, handbook, handouts and pipe sizing software.

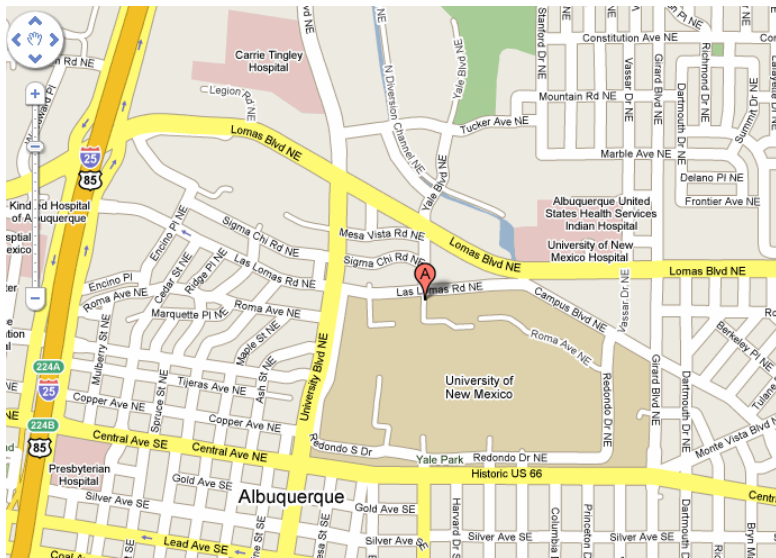
